Prayer Points for Israel: Pray for...

- 1. Please pray for the hostages to be returned, including the youngest, Kfir Bibas, who turned one year old on January 18. See here a list of them. (Psalm 126).
- 2. Please pray against the pressure (including from the U.S.) for a two-state solution, giving the Palestinian Authority governance. As we know, they do not recognize Israel's right to exist (Joel 3:1-2).
- 3. Pray for the protection of the IDF soldiers fighting in Gaza. Please pray specifically for IDF soldiers known to our community: Jonathan Glazer, Itamar Glazer, Elyasaf Sacher, Amichai Sacher, Tiara Sacher, Assaf Frankel, Chaim Malespin, Achinoam, Uriyahu, Tal, Yonathan, Mathew, Tsuriyah, Anael, Tsuriel, Gideon, and Yonatan the 2nd (Psalm 121).
- 4. Pray for the war Israel is also fighting in the north with Hezbollah as well as in Judea and Samaria and within Israel as Hamas infiltration terrorists wage the war within (Psalm 91).
- 5. Pray for Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu. Pray for wisdom, health, encounters with the Lord, and unity with the parliament members. May there be unity in the nation (Psalm 133).
