Prayer Points for Israel: Pray for ...

1. Please pray for hostages Shiri Bibas and her two young red-headed children, Ariel and Kfir (aged four years and nine months at the time of the kidnapping). The husband/father, Yardin, is also a hostage at a different location. Ariel and Kfir are the only remaining children in captivity. It is not known whether they are alive or deceased since they were surrendered to a different faction of terrorists operating with Hamas (Jeremiah 33:7). 2. Please pray for all of the hostages to be freed and that the negotiations for their release will be favorable to the IDF in accomplishing all goals in the war. See <u>here</u> a list of the hostages still missing (Psalm 126).

3. Please pray for the ability to defeat Hamas by March 10, which is the start of Ramadan, when historically more terrorist activities occur. Pray much can be accomplished before Ramadan begins. It ends on April 9 (Psalm 31:15).

4. Pray for Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and the government and military leaders to have wisdom in the way forward in the war and governance of Gaza post-war. May they have the wisdom of the sons of Issachar to discern the times and know what to do (I Chronicles 12:32).
5. Pray for protection for the IDF soldiers (Psalm 91). Our community knows the following IDF soldiers: Jonathan Glazer, Itamar Glazer, Elyasaf Sacher, Amichai Sacher, Tiara Sacher, Assaf Frankel, Chaim Malespin, Achinoam, Uriyahu, Tal, Yonathan, Mathew, Tsuriyah, Anael, Tsuriel, Gideon, and Yonatan the 2nd.

6. Pray for the rise of more Isaiah 62 Watchmen on the Wall for Israel across the nations.
Pray for a worship movement to sweep Israel, such as what was seen in the days of
Jehoshaphat in 2 Chronicles 20. The worship arose, and the enemies of Judah were defeated.
Pray for unity in Israel and repentance for disunity. Where the first months of the war showed
great unity in the land, it is now being shaken in lieu of disunity regarding the hostage situation,
war effort, and media portrayals of the government. (2 Chronicles 7:14, 15 and Psalm 133).

7. Pray for the Palestinian people to depart from radicalization and hatred of the Jewish people.

8. Pray they help to end the war with the return of the hostages and revolt against Hamas.

9. Continue to pray for the exposure and breaking of evil alliances against Israel, such as organizations that financially support Hamas, like UNRWA and the UN. Pray for the defunding of all financial support of terror.

10. Pray against global antisemitism. Pray for truth to prevail (Psalm 25:5).
